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Fort Belvoir to Conduct Ongoing Blasting Operations at Fort Belvoir North Area

Engineers will perform controlled blasts over the next few months on the Fairfax County Parkway Project jobsite to remove rock encountered during earthwork operations at the post's Fort Belvoir North Area (formerly the Engineer Proving Ground). Blasts may occur daily and there may be multiple blasts on any given day. All blasting will take place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. The controlled blasts are needed to facilitate the building of Fairfax County Parkway Project. The location of the blasting will be within the confines of the Fort Belvoir North Area. This operation will take place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. to minimize disturbance to the surrounding neighborhoods.

The Fairfax County Parkway Project is part of a vital transportation corridor serving residents and businesses located in the Fairfax County neighborhoods. Cherry Hill Construction, Inc. has been selected by Eastern Federal Highway Land Division to design build the extension of the Fairfax County Parkway at Rolling Rd to Fullerton Rd.
